


STEP 1

Go to the 'Settings' menu.






Turn on 'Display VCA Rule'




Go back to the 'Home' screen.






Click on the required camera to test.





You will be viewing the Live-View, with the VCA Rule (ie: Perimeter Protection) on the screen.


In this example, the VCA Rule is a line crossing rule shown by a blue line.





Move a target (ie: person or vehicle) towards the VCA Rule.


The target will begin being tracked by the camera, indicated by a green box around the target.






As the target crosses the line, the perimeter protection event is triggered.

This is confirmed by both the line and the target box both turning red.





After 2 seconds, the line and target return to their normal state, ready to be tested again.





To turn off VCA Rules, return to the 'Me' > 'Settings' menu and turn off VCA Rules.

This will prevent them from being shown on the screen.
